Selection process:

1. All player must be registered online via: https://www.toornament.com/en_GB/tournaments/3874250363777441792/registration/

2. All the players must join our Discord, Join Link: https://discord.gg/4wC359x

3. Players are required to update the full details i.e. nickname (in game nick with the tag), email.

4. Teams are required to report 30 mins before their match. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.

5. Hacking results will be permanently ban from all the AORUS Events and Valorant Bangladesh Community.

Map-pool:

- Haven
- Bind
- Split
- Ascent

Team captains of each team will have to choose maps and sides as described:

BO1:

Team 1 bans a map from the map pool.

- Team 2 bans a map from the map pool.
- Team 1 picks a map from the remaining 2 maps.
- Team 2 will pick a side (Attackers/Defenders) to start on.

BO3:

The team on the top – choosing the first map from the map pool.

The team on the bottom – choosing which side they will start on the first map.

The team on the bottom – choosing the second map from the map pool.

The team on the top – choosing which side on which they will start on the second map.

The team on the bottom – choosing the third map from the map pool.

The team on the top – choosing which side on which they will start on the third map.

Game Server Location:

Matches will be played in SEA servers.

Server Setup:

Map: depending on which map was selected to be played from the map pool

Mode: Standard Options

Allow Cheats: Off

Tournamen<mark>t Mode: On</mark>

Overtime: Teams will alternate playing rounds on attack and defense until a team claims victory by being up by 2 rounds

Number of **Players**:

Maximum number of 7 players will be allowed. No player other than that will be allowed to play. Breaking this rule can bring heavy penalty like disqualification.
